








The judges examine each gaming business in the Asian gaming industry and assign points based on GGR and EBITDA. Those points are then allocated between the organization's key one, two or more key executives. Scores are then adjusted up or down for a multitude of positive and negative factors. The final stage of the judging process involves examining the list for reasonableness and looking at key head to head match ups and making appropriate minor adjustments.
